LAW 6 THE BAT

1. Width and length

The bat overall shall not be more than 38 inches/96.5cm in length. The blade of the bat shall be made solely of wood and shall not exceed 4 1/4 in/10.8cm at the widest part.

2. Covering the blade

The blade may be covered with material for protection, strengthening or repair. Such material shall not exceed. 1/16 in/l.56mm in thickness, and shall not be likely to cause unacceptable damage to the ball.

3. Hand or glove 10 count as part of bat

In these Laws,

- (a) reference to the bat shall imply that the bat is held by the batsman.
- (b) contact between the, ball and
 - either (i) the striker's bat itself
 - or (ii) the striker's hand holding the bat
 - or (iii) any part of a glove worn on the striker's hand holding the bat shall be regarded as the ball striking or touching the bat, or being struck by the bat.
