Sub: Appointment of Electoral Officer for Mumbai Cricket Association elections

Pursuant to the order dated 9th August 2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India (copy enclosed), BCCI has registered its Constitution and subsequently Mumbai Cricket Association, through its Committee of Administrators, has also registered its constitution with the Charity Commissioner on 12th September 2018.

Rule no. 33 (1) of the registered MCA Constitution reads as under:

"Atleast four weeks prior to the Annual General Meeting at which an election is to be held, Apex Council shall appoint an Electoral Officer, who shall be a former State Election Commissioner. In the event of such a person not being available, any appropriate officer from the state election commission nominated by the present state election commissioner shall be appointed as electoral officer. It is further provided that until the Apex Council is formed, the Chief Executive Officer is authorised to get the above officer appointed as the Electoral Officer.

As per the Press Release issued by Supreme Court Appointed Committee of Administrators dated 21st May 2019 (copy enclosed), state associations are required to complete the elections by 14th September 2019.

We propose to hold the elections at the earliest and hence we would request you to kindly nominate a former state election commissioner or an appropriate officer from the state election commission to conduct the Mumbai Cricket Association elections and oblige.
