Dear Sir/s and Ma'am.

As you are aware, subsequent to the order of Bombay High Court we are filling the agreed constitution of MCA with the Charity Commissioner today since the written order was received only yesterday. Subsequent to which the notifications for elections can be issued. Our case is very much different from any other association and must be viewed as a rarest of rare case.

Mr.C.S.Naik (C.E.O.) and Mr. Ganesh Iyer (Adhoc Managing Committee member) met the Learned Amicus Curiae on 25th September 2019 at 6.00 pm and got a letter for relaxation of notice period from him yesterday evening.

You are aware that even if we had started the process of election as per our constitution, it would have taken us 45 days to hold the elections. We are undertaking to conduct the elections on 11th October which is within 15 days from today condensing our requirement.

It is our earnest request that you grant us extension till 11th October to conduct the election and the Apex Council to represent its nominee to BCCI before 15th October 2019. Please treat us as a special case considering the circumstances and we hope to receive a favorable and just response.
